Personal attributes:

1. Is in good standing at a Christian church, with a servant's heart for leadership
2. Willing to be involved in prayer ministry crossing ethnic and denominational lines
3. Believes in and is committed to the Promise Keepers Seven Promises
4. Strong communication skills, both written and verbal
5. Willing to submit to the Prayer Booth Captain and the Prayer Coordinator
6. Committed to pray in the Prayer Booth at the Conference site during your scheduled time

Pre-Conference responsibilities:

1. Help recruit pastors and/or ministry leaders to work in the Prayer Booth during the Conference and submit candidates to the Prayer Booth Captain or to the Prayer Coordinator
2. The Prayer Booth Team is staffed with men. They do not need to purchase a ticket to the conference, since they are volunteering.
3. Receive your assignment shift from the Prayer Booth Captain
4. Familiarize yourself with general conference information
5. Discuss Prayer Booth operations with Prayer Booth Captain
6. Pray for the Conference
7. This is a good time to minister to each other and pray for each other's families

Conference weekend:

1. Stop by the Prayer Room to be prayed for before your assigned shift
2. Pray with men one-on-one
3. Last shift - Assist with breakdown of the Prayer Booth and clean up activities
